#### IMPRISIS OIDC CLIENT FOR MS365



- IOCM allows seamless access to MS Graph APIs from the HCL Notes Client
- **IOCM** is a local Web Server with an Authorization Proxy Application
- It handles OpenID flows and MFA Authentication flows
- **IOCM** also proxies HTTP requests and enriches them with appropriate access tokens



- IOCM also keeps track of token expiration and refresh token handling
- LotusScript users don't need to see/access/work with tokens at all.
- IOCM supports MS Graph API Rights segregation with different access rights on MS365






HCL Notes/Domino brings all we need for deployment out of the box.
